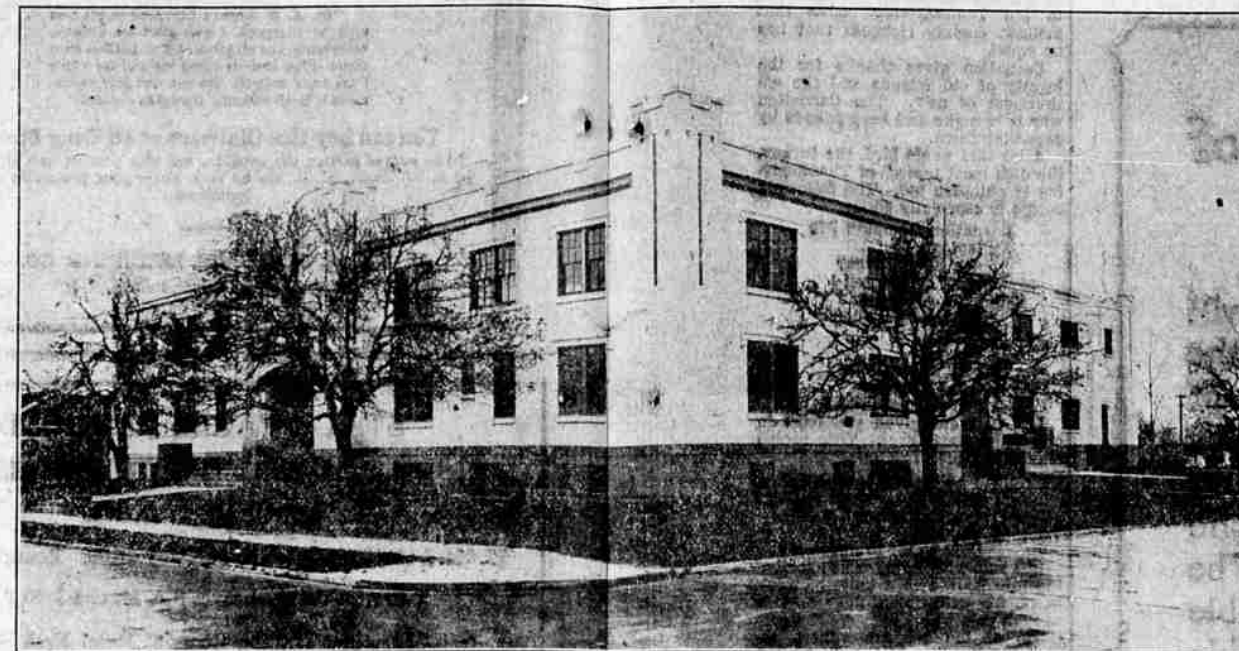

THE NEW ARMORY has two stories and a basement, has a frontage of 128 feet on Bartlett street and 190 feet on Third avenue, cost \$80,000 and is one of the finest in the state.

All the walls and bearing partitions are of reinforced concrete with white cement finish on the outside and the entire structure is constructed of the best materials, under the direction of R. I. Stuart, the local contractor.

Architect Hinsacker of Eugene drew the plans and represented the state. The building will be dedicated tomorrow, Tuesday evening, with a splendid program and the public is cordially invited. Adjutant General White and his staff and either Governor Pierce or his representative will attend and take part in the program.
