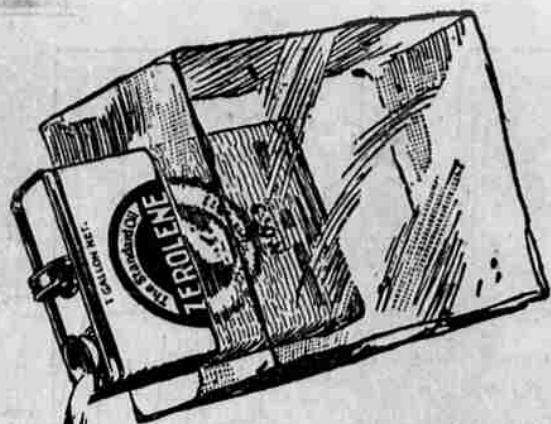

## BOGGS CAN STAY AS LONG AS 'LAW ISN'T ENFORCED'

SALEM, Nov. 28.—Governor Pierce may appoint special prosecutors in such counties as he feels that the laws are not being properly enforced and may retain them there so long as such a condition continues to exist, according to Attorney General Van Winkle. The opinion of the attorney general is understood to apply specifically to the case in Jackson county, where O. C. Boggs is serving as special prosecutor.

SALEM, Ore., Nov. 28.—O. C. Boggs is special prosecutor in Jackson county despite the fact Rawles Moore resigned as district attorney there and was succeeded by N. W. Borden, who was appointed to fill the vacancy by Governor Pierce. This was the substance of a legal opinion written today by Attorney General Van Winkle in reply to a letter received from Governor Pierce. The attorney general held that the offices of district attorney and special prosecutor are separate and have no connection as far as the law is concerned.

Mr. Boggs was appointed special prosecutor in Jackson county to take charge of liquor cases. A controversy is now raging there between Mr. Boggs and Mr. Borden with relation to their respective jurisdictions.

## MOROS WAVE RED FLAG, 4 KILLED

MANILA, Nov. 28.—(By Associated Press). Governor Santos of Lanao province, on the island of Mindanao, advising constabulary headquarters here of the killing of four Moro outlaws, declared the encounter occurred in the market place of the hamlet after Dato (chief) Pauduk, a Moro, had made a seditious speech inciting his hearers to fight the authorities.

According to Governor Santos, Pauduk has been swearing other Moro chieftains on the koran, the book of Mohammedanism, which is the Moro religion, to espouse his cause, and already has gathered a considerable number of men under him.

Two datos at Taraka have hoisted the red flag, the Moro symbol of unrest, their object being, in the opinion of Governor Santos, to bluff the government and thus gain prominence among the Moros who are numerous in Lanao province.

## WASHINGTON STATE TO GROW FORESTS

OLYMPIA, Wash., Nov. 28.—Acting under the authority granted by the last legislature, the state forest board will purchase approximately eight thousand acres of logged-off land in Clarke and Skamania counties, at \$1.25 an acre and will combine them with other lands in the same locality in a reforestation project. The lands adjoin the Columbia national forest.

The bonds which bear an unusually low rate of interest under the state act, are not general obligation bonds against the state but are secured by the lands themselves. The Northern Pacific Railway company will buy the bonds.

Governor Hart, Clark V. Savidge, commissioner of public lands, Fred E. Pape, supervisor of forestry and Hugo Winkenwerder, dean of the college of forestry, University of Washington attended the conference.

## AGED ORCHARD WORKER ACQUITTED OF CRIME

C. L. Carter, age 64 years, an orchard worker, charged with a statutory offense, involving an eight year old boy, was acquitted by a jury in the circuit court Tuesday night, after five hours' deliberation. The balloting stood 11 to one for acquittal from the start, one member of the jury holding out for conviction.

The circuit court at the completion of this case adjourned until next Monday, December 3.

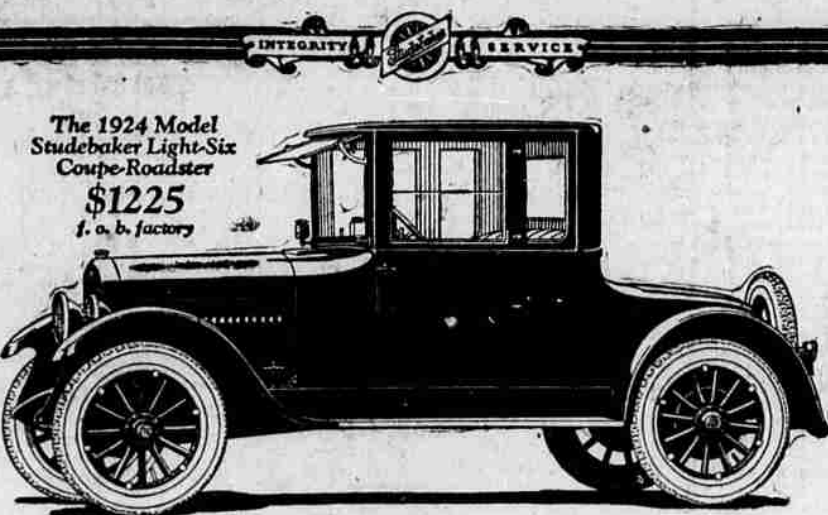

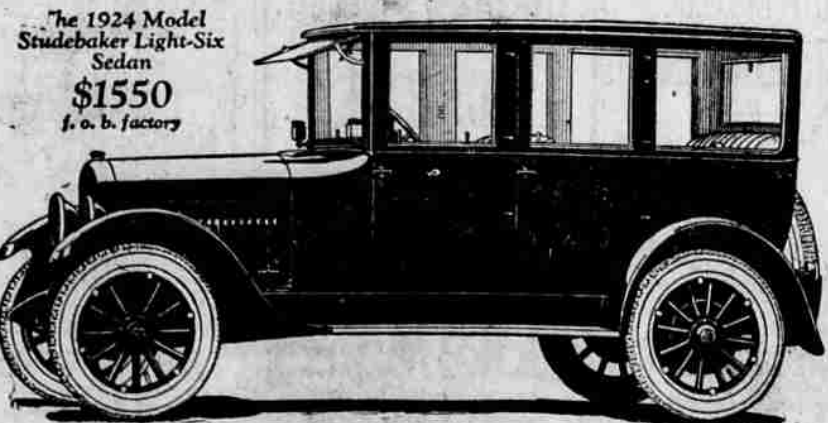
