

BRINGING UP FATHER

WIFE MURDERER
DECLARED INSANE

MILWAUKEE, Dec. 17.—E. Ray Tompkins, held on a charge of first degree murder, is insane, according to the findings of a lunacy commission of five alienists, made public today.

Tompkins confessed to George Shaughnessy, district attorney to killing his wife, whose beheaded body was found December 6. He said he strangled her into unconsciousness and then removed her head which he destroyed in a furnace fire.

It is expected Tompkins will be committed to a hospital for the criminal insane and if a cure is effected he will be returned here to be tried on the charge against him.
