

COMMANDER OF WRECKED FLOTILLA CUT 150 NUMBERS

WASHINGTON, Dec. 27.—Captain Edward H. Watson, commander of the destroyer squadron wrecked on the California coast, near Point Honda, last September, will lose 150 numbers, and Lieutenant Commander Donald T. Hunter, commander of the destroyer Delphy, one of the squadron, will lose 100 numbers as a result of naval court martial sentences approved yesterday by Secretary Donahy.

In approving the findings in the case of Captain Watson, Secretary Donahy said that officer would be placed at the foot of the captains' list of the present date and there remain until he has lost 150 numbers in his grade.

Captain Watson is now number 66 in the list of captains and has but six years to serve before he will retire on account of age. Commander Hunter, who was in charge of the flagship of the destroyer squadron, now occupies place number 149 on the list of lieutenant commanders.

FARM LABOR TO SUPPORT M'ADOO

SIoux Falls, S. D., Dec. 27.—Democrats and farmer labor elements in at least two counties decided to form a coalition to support William G. McAdoo for president at county proposal meetings yesterday. The proposal gatherings were held throughout the state to ratify actions taken at the recent party conventions held at Pierre when presidential and state office candidates were nominated. The county meetings yesterday also approved county and legislative tickets.

Lincoln and Moody were two of the counties in which democrats and farmer labor men endorsed McAdoo, and a partial success in this direction is reported from Minnehaha county.

The Coddington county republicans proposal unanimously endorsed Hiram Johnson of California for president and then proposed a county ticket to run in the independent column in primary ballot. Thus, there will be no majority county ticket.
