

OHIO DELEGATION TO VOTE SOLID FOR PRESIDENT

COLUMBUS, Ohio, Dec. 25.—President Coolidge was endorsed for the presidential nomination at the Cleveland convention next June by the Ohio republican state central committee meeting here today. Party leaders say this probably means that the Ohio delegation vote will be cast solidly for Coolidge.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 28.—Hiram Johnson intends to contest with President Coolidge for southern delegates at the Cleveland convention. He announced today he would enter the Alabama primary.

PIERRE, S. D., Dec. 28.—A petition proposing Hiram Johnson as candidate for president in the independent column of the republican primary balloting in South Dakota was filed with the secretary of state today, along with the acceptance of the proposal by the California senator. This with the formal acceptance by President Coolidge as majority republican candidate is declared by party leaders as the final clinching of the party primary election fight in South Dakota.

5 POSTAL CLERKS IN ROBBING PLOT

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 28.—The arrest of five men, all temporary post-office clerks here early this morning has revealed a gigantic and well organized plot for the systematic looting of Christmas mails in Los Angeles, according to postal inspectors and deputy sheriffs who made the arrests. The officers first took into custody Irving Kasher, and it was through disclosures made by him that led to the arrest of the other four, Coote Kemp, Robert Gilmore, Walter Bruhn and Charles Losh. Their ages range from 19 to 30 years. The officers refused to divulge the amount of loot secured by the men and it was learned that the amount would run into thousands of dollars.

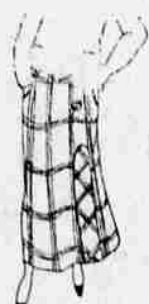
