## LA FOLLETTE WILL OPPOSE COOLIDGE DAKOTA PRIMARY

FARGO, N. D., Jan. 18.—(By the Associated Press.)—A movement to place the name of Senator Robert M. La Follette of Wisconsin on the ballot at the March 18 primary in this state as a candidate for president and an announcement that two sets of Coolidge delegates to the republican convention would be in the race, were important developments last night in North Dakota politics. Following conferences here with La Follette's supporters, Gerald Nye of Cooperstown, candidate for congressman from the second district, said that a state wide campaign would be started immediately to put Mr. La Follette's name on the ballot.

At a meeting yesterday the "Independent" republican state committee endorsed President Coolidge and called a convention for Bismarck on February 14 to name thirteen delegates to the Cleveland convention as well as a candidate for national committee. The regular republican committee meeting recently at Bismarck had endorsed President Coolidge and named its thirteen delegate candidates. Efforts by J. B. Hannan, Coolidge campaign manager in North Dakota, to effect a compromise with the "Independent" committee yesterday failed. He proposed a new committee in which the various factions would get together, but his offer was turned down.

EL CENTRO, Cal., Jan. 18.—A judgment awarding Mrs. Martha Cox \$10,000 damage for the burning to death of her husband while a prisoner in the Calipatria, Cal. jail, April 1, 1923, was on file in the superior court here today. It was charged by the plaintiff in her suit against Calipatria officials that the city marshal who had charge of the jail was negligent in not removing matches from the pockets of an intoxicated prisoner placed in the one-room jail with Cox. This prisoner is believed to have started the fire which caused Cox's death.

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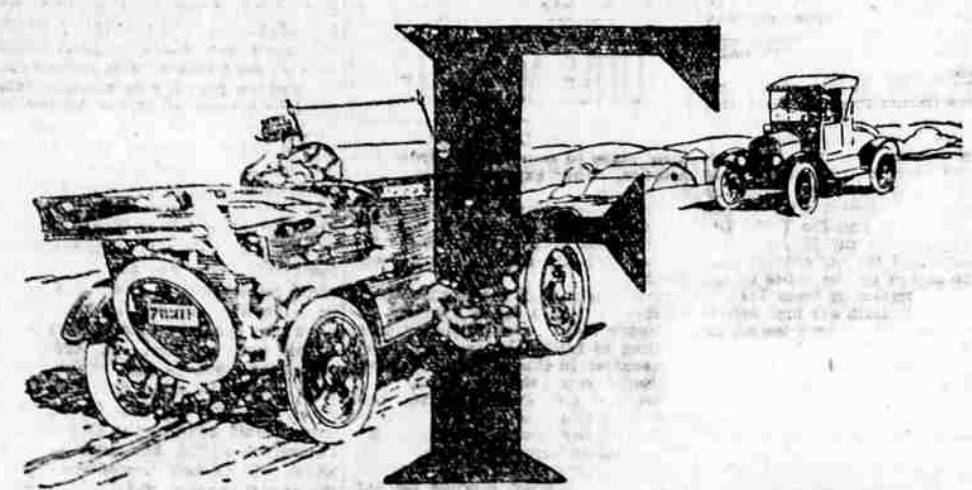
