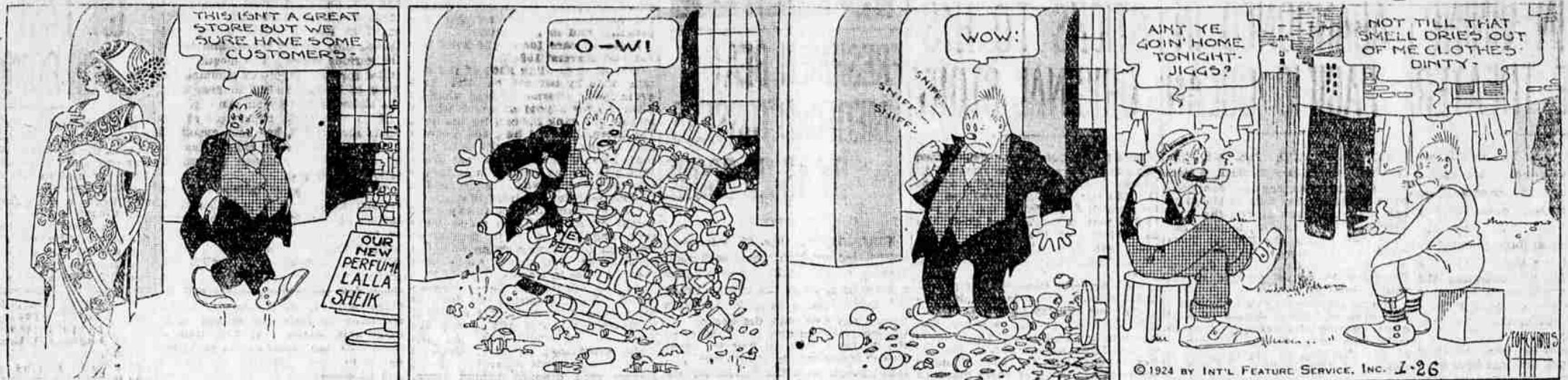

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DUKHOBORS BUY 875 ACRES NEAR EUGENE, OREGON

SPOKANE, Jan. 26.—Peter Verigin, head of the Doukhobor settlements in Canada, is here to consult with immigration officials in preparation for the establishment of an experimental farm in Lane county, Oregon.

Verigin who has recently purchased 875 acres of land for the purpose, believes that members of the colony can make a success of growing wheat, alfalfa and fruit in Oregon. It is planned to bring four or five members of one of the Canadian colonies to the new land within a month to organize the work.
