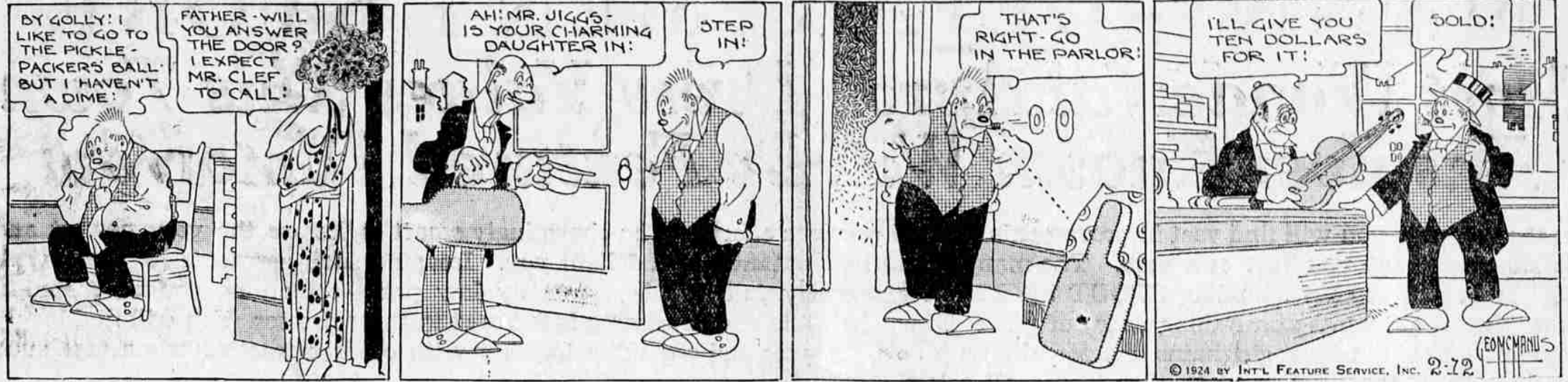

GOVERNOR CALLS A ROAD ELECTION IN COOS, MARCH 24

SALEM, Ore., Feb. 12.—Governor Pierce last night issued a proclamation setting Tuesday, March 24, as the date for a special election in Coos county on the question of whether that county shall be declared a highway improvement district. The proclamation of the governor is pursuant to petitions from Coos county filed with Secretary of State Rorer containing the required number of signatures to place the issue on the ballot. The secretary of state at once informed the governor that the petitions had been filed and has now notified the Coos county clerk that the election has been called. The entire procedure is under an act passed by the legislature of 1921, sponsored by Senator Charles Hall of Coos county and others, which provides for the formation of highway improvement districts in a manner similar to the formation of irrigation districts. There was practically no opposition to the measure in the legislature.
