YAKIMA, Wash., Feb. 27.—Yakima's apple crop will be cleaned up by April 1, according to shippers which will be the earliest cleanup on the valley crop for several years. There are 3,933 cars, mostly Winesaps, remaining. Shipments averaged 455 cars a week in February. Extra fancy Winesaps are selling f. o. b. at \$1.35 to \$1.40 a box.
