

7 YEARS' TIME TO PAY FOR CITY LOTS PURCHASED

The city lot sale closes tomorrow afternoon at five o'clock and lots remaining unsold will be withdrawn from the market for an indefinite period.

The terms under which these lots

have been offered are one hundred dollars down, balance in semi-annual installments for seven years with six percent interest on deferred payments.

A discount of ten per cent on the purchase price will be given to those who build a residence on any lot purchased at this sale.

With the building permits issued since the first of this month the total so far for 1924 is over three hundred thousand dollars which is seventy-five per cent of the total of the permits issued for the entire year of 1923.

Medford faces the greatest building era since the early days of its development and the prospects are good for more than a million dollars of building permits being issued this year.

BEARS WIN TITLE BUT ARE FORCED TO LIMIT BY HUSKIES

OAKLAND, Cal., March 7.—After repelling invading basketeers from the University of Washington in two of the most spectacular and bitterly con-

tested cage clashes ever witnessed here, the University of California today wears the championship crown of the Pacific coast conference in basketball.

The Bears emerged from the culminating affray of the season last night with a 28 to 25 victory, after administering a 32 to 31 defeat to the Huskies Tuesday evening. So evenly matched were the two quintets however, that an extra five minutes of play was necessary to decide the winner in both contests, and so furious was the floor work of the players that both teams were fagged and worn at the conclusion of the melees.

Behind their scoring aces, Frayne

and Hesketh, Washington presented a formidable defensive play that forced the Californians to their limit, Washington led during most of the first half of last night's contest, but the heavy Bears crept forward into a tie with a slashing onslaught in the final period and raced to victory with two baskets in the extra session of play.

Close team work, speed on the floor and careful guarding marked the play of both teams. As the quintets battled for a slight advantage in the final half the score often stood at a tie, and the outcome was in doubt until the crack of the final gun.
