ATLANTA, Ga., Dec. 15.—C. A. Roark, who Saturday shot and killed Miss Vena Moore as she was sending at a multiplex in the Western Union office here, is either insane or is feigning insanity, police officers stated last night.

Immediately after shooting Miss Moore as she was at work in a telephone room with 100 employees, Roark, a multiplex supervisor of the company, declared he had killed the girl because she had threatened to ruin his wife. He fired four shots into her body and during the panic caused in the office by the shooting, surrendered to several employees.
