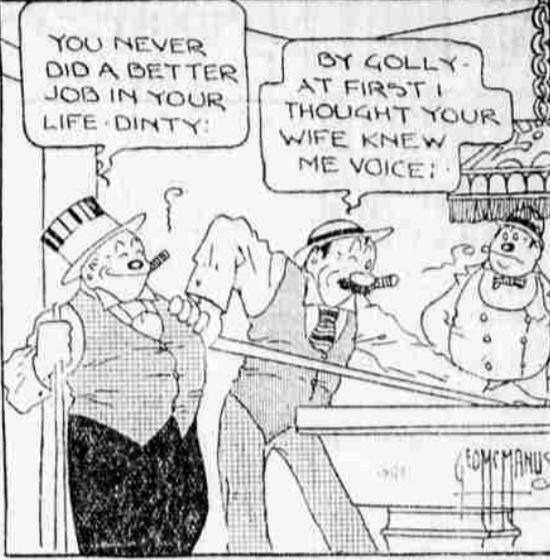

HIGHER PRICES IN PORTLAND MARKET FOR EGG CERTAIN

PORTLAND, Ore., Jan. 12.—High egg prices can be expected by the Portland trade regardless of what other markets do unless there is some improvement in the local receipts. Dealers along the street this morning report that very few eggs are coming in and there is a scramble for supplies. Other prices have continued to soar in the face of the weakness in the eastern markets. Buyers are offering 47 to 48 cents in the country for current receipts and getting very few shipments at that. Cold rainy weather has reduced the lay and little increase in production is expected this month. Potato buyers out through the producing sections of the state over the week-end had very little success in obtaining stocks. They found the growers decidedly bullish and unwilling to sell. One buyer who ran into a fancy lot of Burbanks offered as high as \$2 without obtaining the potatoes. He says that he ran into very little frost damage.
