PROVES TO BE A
BRUTAL MURDER

LOS ANGELES, Cal., April 29.—The death of Mrs. W. H. Babcock, 68-year-old widow, which yesterday was reported to police as due to natural causes and which last night developed into a murder mystery when an autopsy surgeon found skull fractures, broken ribs and other evidences of a brutal attack, continued to puzzle investigators today.

Miss Elizabeth Dupree, niece of the dead woman, told detectives she had found the body of her aunt lying in an apartment below the one in which they had been living. She awoke from a nap after lunch, she explained, and missing Mrs. Babcock, went downstairs to look for her. Discovery of the body followed.

The detectives, learning that Mrs. Babcock had been subject to fainting spells, decided she must have suffered a fatal hemorrhage and, in failing to the floor received the ugly wound they noticed on her head. An undertaker later called the coroner's attention to the woman's battered skull and an autopsy appeared to establish the case as one of murder. Blood-stained newspapers thrust under the corner of the carpet in the apartment showed the murderer had attempted to conceal evidence of a struggle.

No motive for the killing was apparent, however.

Diamonds valued at \$2000 were on the body and the contents of the house had not been disturbed.

DIRIGIBLES N. G.
FOR POLAR FIGHT
EXPERT DECLARES

NEW YORK, April 30.—Walter Wellman, former Arctic explorer and the first man to attempt to cross the Atlantic in a dirigible, has declared that he believes the MacMillan polar expedition this summer, which will be accompanied by three navy planes, has a good chance for success. But he does not believe a dirigible would be able to reach the pole, nor does he believe that the Los Angeles or the Shenandoah could be used effectively in rescue work there should a rescue be necessary.

Secretary of the Navy Wilbur had announced that the dirigibles would be utilized as rescue craft in case any mishap should befall the party.

"A dirigible wouldn't have any chance in a thousand of rescuing anybody from the polar cap," Mr. Wellman said. "She'd be lucky to get back herself."

Besides being impotent to aid stranded explorers because of the impossibility of landing without a big ground crew, Mr. Wellman pointed out there would be grave danger of the Los Angeles becoming marooned and wrecked through the loss of her buoyancy. In summer, he said, the polar basin is flooded with sunlight 23 hours of the day, and he added:

"The air above the ice fields heats up to 70 or 75 degrees and may drop in an hour to the freezing point if the sky becomes overcast. Such a sudden drop of temperature—common to the Arctic—might mean disaster to an airship whose buoyancy is dependent upon gas."

Airplanes today are dependable with a very small element of hazard, he said, but airships are unwieldy and extra hazardous and will remain so.
