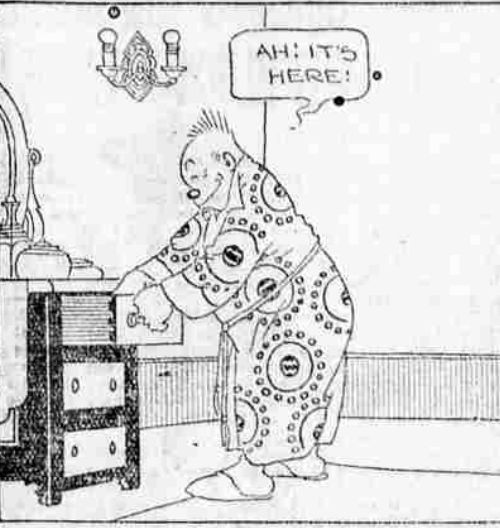
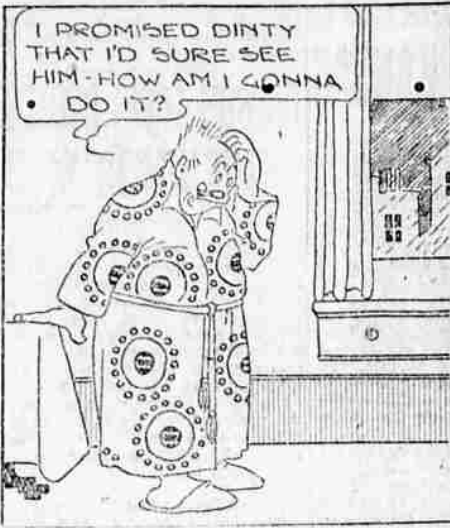

PORTLAND, Ore., May 2.—(U. S. Department of Agriculture.)—Live-stock steady. Cattle receipts 40; compared with a week ago. Most classes steady; with spots 10¢ to 25¢ lower on weighty steers; week's bulk prices: Beef steers \$8.00 to \$10.00; top Monday \$10.10; cows and heifers \$6.00 to \$8.50; canners and cutters \$2.50 to \$5.00; hogs \$3.50 to \$5.00; a few butchers up to \$6.00; best light veal calves \$10.50 to \$11.00; others \$5.00 to \$10.00.

Hogs receipts 170. Today's sale of butcher hogs at \$12; looks barely steady to weak considering quality; compared to week ago. Butcher grades and packing rows \$1.00 to \$1.55 lower; slaughter pigs \$1.50 lower; feeders 50¢ lower; week's bulk prices: Desirable weight butchers \$12.50 to \$13.25; extreme top Friday, \$12.50; hogs and underweights \$12 down; packing rows \$10.50 to \$11.00; mostly \$10 Friday; feeder pigs mostly \$10.00 to \$10.50, few Monday at \$11.00.

Sheep, spring lambs closed 25¢ lower than week ago; other classes nominally steady; bulk of spring lambs for the week \$15.00 to \$15.75; extreme top Friday \$15.00; aged stock practically absent; half shorn lambs Friday \$10.75.

DECLARE 'MURDER' A NATURAL DEATH

LOS ANGELES, May 2.—Investigation of the death of Mrs. W. H. Babcock, wealthy widow whose bruised and battered body was found in her apartment house here last Tuesday, has been dropped by police with the announcement that they were convinced it was not a case of murder.

Three skull fractures, eight broken ribs and other injuries revealed by an autopsy after death pronounced by a coroner's jury Thursday returned an open verdict of murder.
