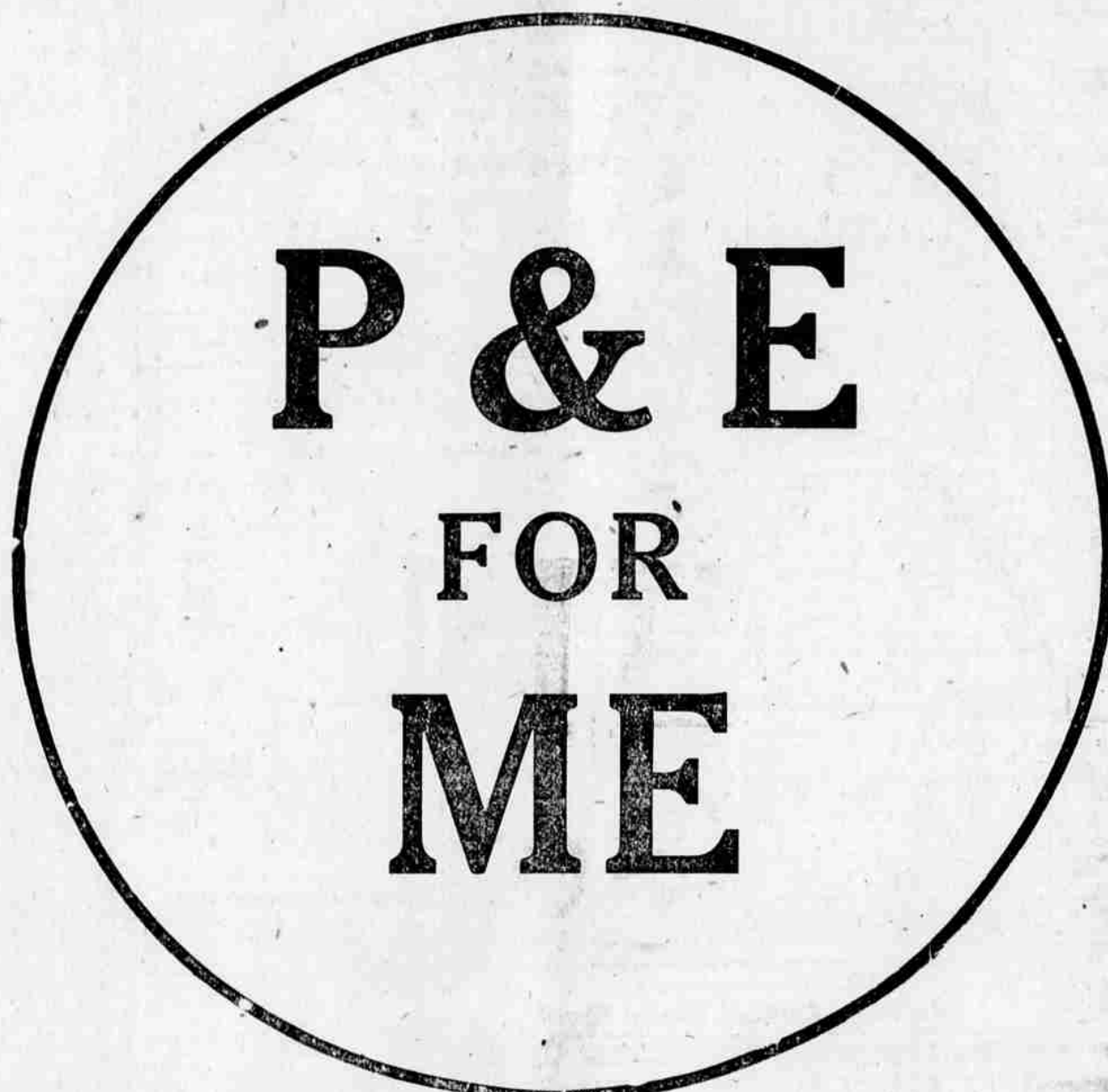
Will Win on Its Merits Tomorrow

14 Reasons Why Voters Should Select the P. & E. Site:

9. THE P. AND E. SITE'S selection will eliminate delay and avoid the expense which would be necessary in condemnation proceedings on the Holly St. site.
10. THE P. AND E. SITE is near both the Pacific Highway and the Crater Lake Highway where buildings could be seen by tourists traveling on either road.
11. THE P. AND E. SITE has natural drainage and better water pressure than can be had on the Holly Street site.
12. THE P. AND E. SITE will serve as one unite of a park system along Bear Creek.
13. THE P. AND E. SITE is endorsed by the school board and by the majority of the students in Medford High school.
14. THE P. AND E. SITE is well situated for athletic grounds and will provide ample parking space for crowds attending athletic contests. It is accessible from both Main street and Jackson street.

A Last Word About the P. & E. Site

A accurate survey this morning showed the level of the P. & E. grounds but fifteen feet below that of the Holly street site.

City engineers are the authority for the statement that the P. & E. site has ample sewerage facilities.

The new school building will be built three hundred feet from the banks of Bear creek and one hundred and fifty feet from Main street.

Investigation shows a firm gravel formation near the surface of the P. & E. site upon which to rest the foundation of the new building.
