REFERENDUM ON MOTOR BUS BILL HALTED BY CARDS

SALEM, Ore., May 26. — A new problem relative to referendum petitions confronts Secretary of State Kozler, and has been put up to the attorney general for solution. This is whether names signed to referendum petitions filed with the secretary of state can be withdrawn by him at the request of the signers. Yesterday he received about 200 postal cards requesting that names be withdrawn from the referendum petitions for the bus bill when these are filed in his office.

The attempted withdrawals were inspired, it is said by the association of county judges and commissioners who are bitterly fighting the referendum and who sent form postcards to several thousand signers of the petitions requesting that they sign them and send them to the secretary of state.
