EUGENE MOONSHINE LEADER CONVICTED

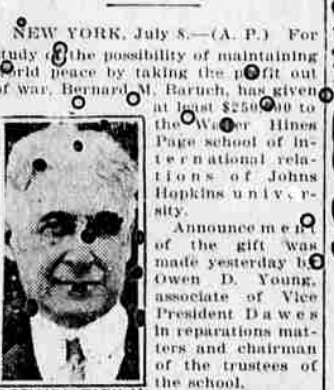
