The enjoyment of a play—like the enjoyment of a meal or a Christmas present—depends largely upon what you expected. If you expected fried chicken and corn on the cob, which you like, and got corn beef and cabbage which you don't, keen disappointment of course resulted. You called it a rotten meal, when as a matter of fact, it may have been an excellent one from the standpoint of Mr. Jiggs.

So with the presentation of the "Rivals" at the Craterian last night by Mrs. Flske and her excellent company of veteran stars and exceptionally capable, but relatively unknown, young people. If you expected Mrs. Flske in gripping realism, Jimmy Powers in Havana, or Chauncey Olcott with Duff's Opera, with Joseph Jefferson's Rip thrown in for good measure you were disappointed, but if you expected a rather tiresome resurrection of an exceedingly old-fashioned comedy, interesting chiefly to the dramatic student or theatrical antiquarian, you were not, in fact you were intensely interested throughout and at times highly entertained.

So there you are as far as any verdict on the "Rivals" is concerned. It all depended on what you expected. To those who knew Sheridan's classic, and knew Mrs. Flske's eccentricities of manner and enunciation, the performance last night was a pleasant surprise. A more difficult part for Mrs. Flske could scarcely be imagined, for Mrs. Malaprop comedy characterization depends almost entirely upon clearness of diction. Nevertheless, in spite of the characteristic staccato, Mrs. Flske made the pre-Victorian dowager convincing and amusing throughout, while her characterization, of course, was as usual distinguished by rare intelligence and subtle artistry. The Bob Acres of James Powers wasn't the Bob Acres of Joseph Jefferson, of course, but in spite of an occasional tendency to burlesque, chiefly facial, the chief comedy role was exceptionally well done. Chauncey Olcott was perfect as O. Tricker, Tom Wise was exceedingly good, while the support from first to last was of supreme excellence.
