Jackson County Is Represented By Six Students O. A. C.

OREGON AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE, Corvallis, July 28.—Jackson county is represented in the attendance at the annual summer session this year by six students, two men and four women. A total of 690 regular and special students were registered for the summer course, an increase of 208 over the attendance last year.

Twenty states are represented by students, some as far away as Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Missouri, North Dakota and South Dakota. Because O. A. C. was designated by the United States Indian service as one of the schools for Indian school teachers to attend during educational leave, 35 men and women instructors in Indian schools from North Dakota, Idaho, Montana, and Washington as well as Oregon, are in attendance.
