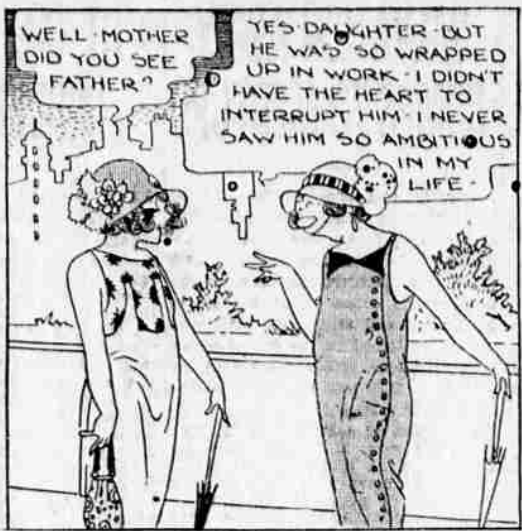

Mussolini's Daughter Saves Drowning Girl

GATTOLICA, Italy, Aug. 5.—(A.P.)—Edda, the fifteen year old daughter of Premier Mussolini, saved the life of a girl swimmer during the severe storm which swept this coast yesterday evening. The premier's daughter reached the helpless girl and supported her until a life guard boat arrived. After the rescue the heroine disappeared immediately, escaping from an enthusiastic demonstration by vacation crowds.
