PHILIPPINE SENATE SELECTS DELEGATES TO VISIT AMERICA

MANILA, Aug. 11.-(A. P.)-Senator Osmena and Speaker Roxas have been selected by a majority of the legislature, as members of a mission which will proceed to the United States for an indefinite stay. The resolution which was introduced in both houses provides that the mission will work for "fulfillment of America's pledge to the Philippines; also seek improvement of the Philippine situation and present to congress petitions and memorials on Philippine problems."

The mission will seek a clear cut definition by congress of the extent of autonomy guaranteed by organic law and increase Philippine power. Senator Osmena planned to depart August 22 on the President Lincoln and Speaker Roxas probably will follow.
