CROSS-COUNTRY BOAT ARRIVES IN CHICAGO EN ROUTE NEW YORK

CHICAGO, Aug. 13.—Three modern pioneer explorers from Los Angeles anchored their motor launch in the Chicago river yesterday after completing 3500 miles of a 5000 mile cross-country jaunt in a boat. The party will leave this week to negotiate the Great Lakes, St. Lawrence and Hudson to New York. They left Astoria, Ore., May 29 and hope to reach New York early in September. They are traveling in a 19-foot craft and, with the exception of a short portage over the continental divide, starting at Cello, Wash., have covered the entire distance in water. Capt. John Hoag, a writer; Frank Wilton, a photographer, and Valentine Woodbury, Los Angeles businessman, are making the trip with a canine mascot, Spy Wapata.
