SPECIAL FEATURES WOMEN OF COUNTY AT COUNTY FAIR

"Are you a farmer? If so, Oregon wants you. More than that, she needs you," states the Volt, the official monthly magazine of the California Oregon Power company.

The fair association is offering the women of Jackson county an opportunity to make a little money aside from the premiums they are to receive in the cooked food.

"Accomplishment is depicted in these scenes. But they are reproduced here because they are a demonstration of possibilities—possibilities of Oregon's vast acreage of unused agricultural lands awaiting settlers.

The first day, the prizes listed in the program book will be awarded, on the following days, merchandise of equal value will be used for the prizes.

"Land of Opportunity"—overworked as the phrase is, it exactly describes Oregon of today. Here is truly a land of opportunity for the settler who has served his apprenticeship in almost any phase of agricultural activity in less favored regions.

"This broad program for bringing settlers to occupy unused agricultural lands has no duplicate anywhere else in the country. Under the plan which has now been in use 22 months, settlers are not only invited to Oregon but selected for location with reference to their previous experience on the land.

"Up to Friday of this week (July 31) the committee's records present evidence of the location of 1012 families. Purchasing 35,000 acres, these new residents have actually invested approximately \$3,500,000 for farm homes.

"An estimate of federal experts places the economic value of a settler and his family at \$5000, raising the known results of the settlement work to a value of \$8,500,000. Satisfied settlers have attracted other families from their home communities, of which the committee has no definite record.

"A complex, but efficient system has been built up by the land settlement department to take care of this rapidly-growing influx of settlers. Every commercial organization in the state receives a weekly list of names of all inquirers. Supplementing the general state booklets sent from the Portland office, all sections of the state thus have opportunity to interest prospective settlers. Their success is measured by what the community has to offer and the efforts of the community leaders.

"One of the most important services of the land settlement department has been to aid settlers after they actually come, to find suitable farm locations. To further facilitate local welcoming newcomers nearly all counties have organized committees whose duty it is to appraise and compile reasonably-priced land listings.

"All counties report sharing results of this co-operative hospitality. Within the past year Marion county has reported 435 out-of-the-state arrivals.
