

3 FOREST FIRES REPORTED, BUT NONE SERIOUS

The lowest humidity on record, given out as 10 degrees, occurred yesterday, and as a result three small forest fires were reported to the local forest service office, all of which are regarded as not dangerous.

A fire attributed to a man burning brush without a proper permit, was reported burning in the Star gulch near the Star ranger station. Forest officials believe the blaze is now under control. A small blaze caused by lightning was reported five miles north of Fort Klamath, but as yet no word has been received regarding the situation there.

Although several fire lookouts reported forest fires in the Butte Falls district, it is thought that the smoke causing them to send in such reports was caused by blazing slashing piles.

A very severe electrical storm is said to have raged in the Prospect and Mount Pitt country last night, but as yet no fires resulting from same have been reported.

W. A. Langell of Salem, state forest inspector, who with Pilot A. DeGiarno of Eugene, flew above the state timberland in southern Oregon yesterday afternoon in a DeHavilland airplane, stated that he is entirely satisfied with the situation in this section. He left for Salem last evening, with the expectation of returning today to examine the forest situation in Klamath county in the same manner.

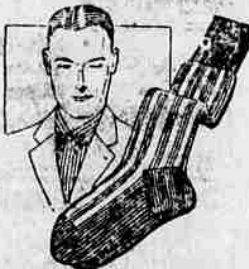
