NO MORE BODIES FOUND IN RUINS

WENATCHEE, Wash., Sept. 9.—No more bodies have been found in the debris at the Great Northern terminal at Appleyard, swept by a flood resulting from a cloudburst in the mountains on Saturday, it was announced today. Three steam shovels and a large crew of men are working night and day to clear up the wreckage. Four persons are known to be missing. The work of clearing the debris was today taken over by the railroad and Chelan county as the result of an agreement reached with the county commissioners. The county has appropriated \$1500 for the work, providing for a crew of 50 men.
