

### WOMAN ATTACKED BY MASKED MAN IN MILL DISTRICT

A woman, whose name is not divulged by local police, was attacked at 11:30 last night in her home by a nocturnal prowler, who became frightened and fled a short time after he had entered the house, located near

the Pacific highway a short distance north of McAndrews street, in the mill district. According to the police, the man, who is described as being short, fat, and wearing several hundred feet west of the house, lying in the grass. The police were summoned to the scene last night a short time after the attack had taken place, Night Patrolman Sunderman hurrying to the scene. He arrived too late, however, to apprehend the missing man. Neighbors say that they had heard the screams issuing from the house, but no action was taken on their part. The police are investigating the case thoroughly, with expectations that developments may occur in the near future.

With last night's happening in mind, Chief of Police Adams warns all housewives, especially those whose husbands work at night, as did the husband in this particular case, to lock all doors, as wandering hoboes come through the city continually.

The council also discussed the advisability of taking some action as a matter of general safety, to slow down the congested auto traffic at intersections of through streets, especially at Riverside and Main and Oakdale and Main streets. The mayor and councilmen, while loath to interfere with legitimate auto traffic, yet recognize the fact that cars must go slower while approaching the thru street intersections, in order to prevent accidents. The general opinion of the city officials seemed to favor the posting of "Go Slow" signs at such intersections, and
