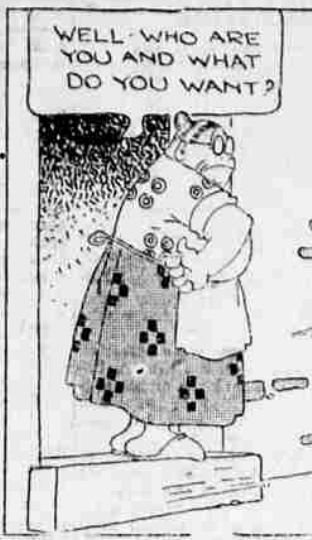


BRINGING UP FATHER

GOSPEL OF CHRIST CHIEF MISSION OF M. E. CHURCH

EUGENE, Ore., Sept. 30.—With the opening session last night the 73rd annual conference of the Methodist Episcopal church got under way with approximately 500 ministers and laymen in attendance. Examinations of undergraduates members were held Monday and yesterday with the welcoming service last evening. "Preaching Jesus Christ is the chief mission of a minister of the gospel," was the message brought by Rev. Melville T. Wire of Astoria, in his address of response at the opening meeting. "We ought all to serve our communities, but when ministers become merely handy men about town the chief reason for their work is lost," he said. Robert A. Booth of Eugene gave the address of welcome. "We have standard schools, standard lumber scales, which makes it impossible for products to pass muster if they are not up to standard; we have standard food and standards for everything we use or do," he said. "Is it possible that in the universe, which was created in the image of God, there is no standard of life? The mission of Jesus Christ was to standardize human action. The purpose of religion, he declared, is to bring people to a right relation to each other. The change in human relations, necessary to bring about a harmony and joy, cannot be accomplished by argument or disputes over the interpretations of the acts of Jesus Christ, he said. Bishop William O. Shepard of Portland was praised by Booth, who declared that there have been many outstanding bishops since the Oregon conference was organized, but none as outstanding as Bishop Shepard. The ministers of the conference were also commended for their work.

BUDGET COMMITTEE WILL MEET MONDAY
