COLLEGE EDUCATION REDUCES FAMILIES

BERKELEY, Calif., Oct. 7.—(A. P.)—After an exhaustive research, Dr. S. J. Holmes, professor of zoology of the University of California has announced that fewer children in the ratio of one to four are born to parents of college education than to parents not graduated from an institution of higher learning.

The report of Dr. Holmes on "size of college families" was based on data gathered from more than 4200 families. He also found that a college educated wife leads to a smaller family than does a college educated husband; that college men tend to marry high school graduates rather than college graduates and that the average number of brothers and sisters of the modern college youth is about 50 per cent less than the number possessed by their parents.
