

BUTTER HOLDINGS ON PACIFIC COAST FALLING RAPIDLY

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 22.—(A. P.)—Butter holdings in coast coolers are falling off rapidly. During the past week the total holdings have been reduced approximately 404,067 pounds.

The report on eggs shows that cooler stocks are shrinking rapidly from week to week. Approximately 33,554 cases have been withdrawn from coast coolers since last week although there are still 95,229 cases more eggs on the coast than a year ago.

Butter holdings on the entire Pacific coast are now only a little more than half as large as a year ago at this time.

From local coolers 4977 cases were withdrawn during the past week, leaving a total of 57,673 cases still in Portland storage. Last year at this time there was 25,629 cases in storage here.

Poultry and country dressed meats are unchanged for the day. Receipts were moderate in both lines with the demand limited.
