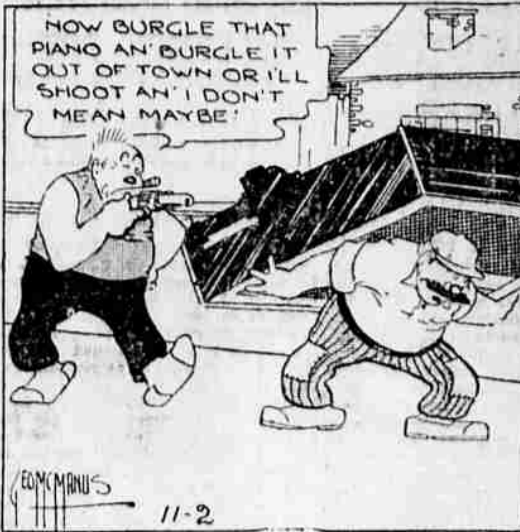

## NOTICE OF SALE OF GOVERNMENT TIMBER

Notice is hereby given that subject to the conditions and limitations of the acts of June 9, 1916 (39 Stat., 218), February 26, 1919 (40 Stat., 1129), and June 4, 1920 (41 Stat., 725), and pursuant to departmental regulations of April 14, 1924 (50 L.
