

**Bear Creek Fruit Make a Big Hit in Fifth Avenue Display**



That southern Oregon fruit is attracting attention in New York is shown by a news story printed in the New York Produce News, issue of October 31, wherein is described prize fruit grown by the Rosenburg Bros., owners and operators of the Bear Creek orchards south of the city. In addition, a large cut, which is here reproduced, shows the fruit and silver cups received as awards for same.

In full, the Produce News says: "An exhibition of fruit, which attracted a great deal of attention, was the one in the store of H. H. Hicks & Son, 675, Fifth Ave., picture of which is shown above. This aroused so much interest that there were crowds in front of the window daily during the five days, October 9 to 13 inclusive, which the exhibit was shown. The crowd became so great at times that it was necessary to employ traffic police to keep the people moving.

"Bulk of the fruit in this window was furnished by the Bear Creek orchards of Medford, Ore., owned and operated by Rosenburg Bros. The four boxes in the foremost of the picture were pears, which had taken prizes in the pear show at Medford last month. In addition to these there were several plates and trays of apples and pears shown exactly as exhibited at that exposition. The five cups shown are of silver and are prizes which have been won by the Bear Creek orchards in recent years for the exhibits of fruit. For the past three years, 1923-24-25, the Bear Creek orchards have won the sweepstakes prize for fruit at this show and the big silver cup in the

center of the exhibit is now their permanent property as are the other smaller cups representing other prizes which this firm has secured. "The pears were packed in half boxes with the Bear Creek orchard's special cushion pack and were handsome specimens of fruit. This orchard is one of the finest in the northwest and makes a specialty of growing and shipping high-grade fruit. The firm has been represented on this market for the past four years by the Thurston Fruit Co."
