MINERAL WEALTH AS A NEW SOURCE OF TAXATION

GRANTS PASS, Dec. 5.—Students of the tax problem admit that there are but two remedies for high taxes—either expenditures must be curtailed or new sources of taxable wealth entered.

Southwestern Oregon, embracing Coos, Curry, Douglas, Jackson, Josephine and Lane counties, has 17,247 square miles of territory—over twice the size of Massachusetts—and of that large area approximately 90 per cent is mountainous.

With the development of the mineral resources of this district, whether on patented lands or in the forest reserve, the taxable wealth of the district will be greatly increased.
