

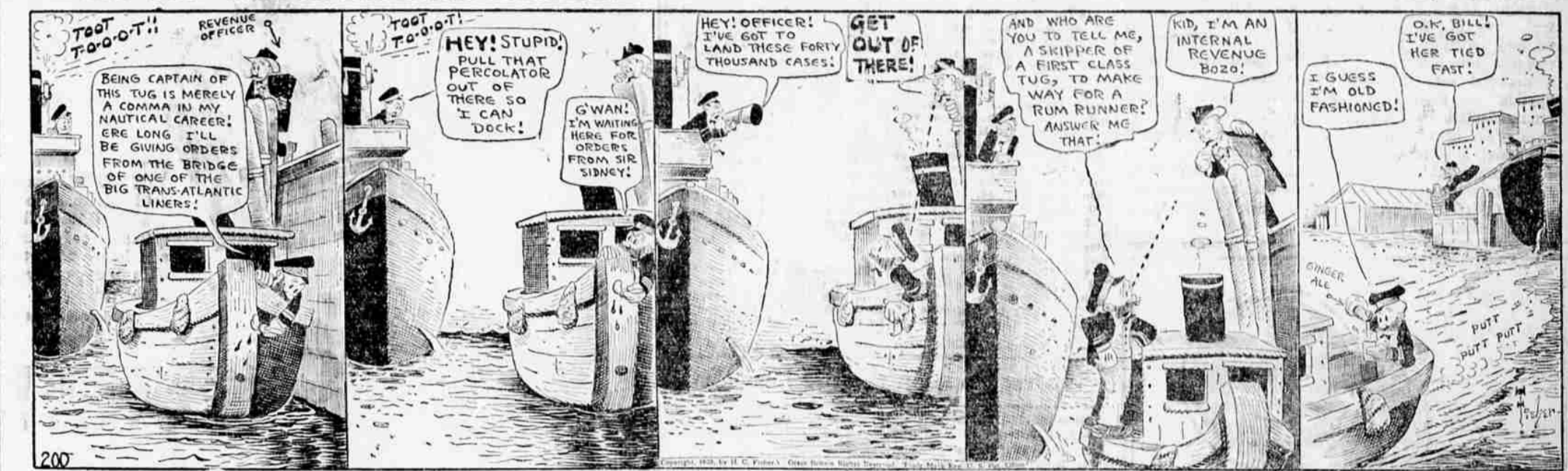
MEXICAN DIVORCE FOR BERLENBACH
