NORMAL NOTES

Southern Oregon Normal has added a number of new courses to the schedule to meet the demands of a growing institution. Psychology of advertising, a course offered by V. V. Caldwell, has created much interest, especially among those taking junior work. In this, the psychological principles are applied to advertising and selling. Advertisements are analyzed as to color, paper size of type, location in newspaper or magazine, and as to cost of advertising compared with the returns netted. This is a three-hour course and eighteen students have signed for it.
