

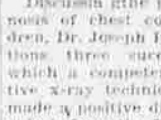

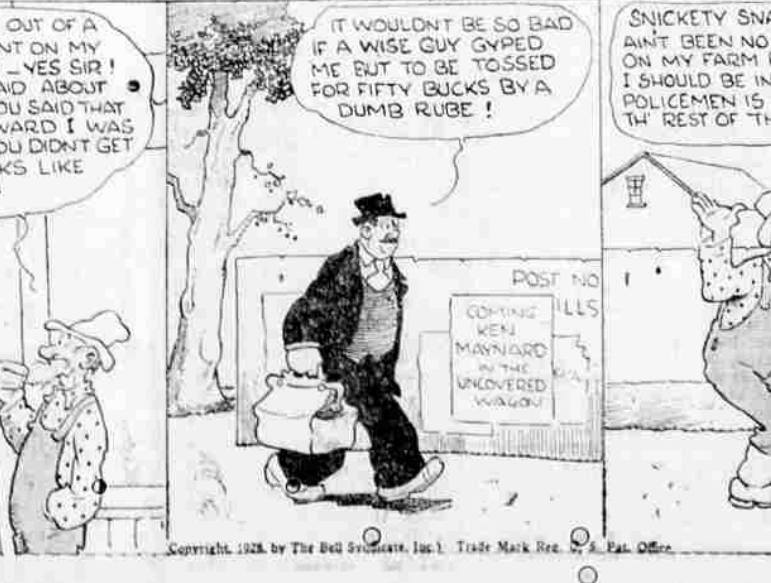
Six hundred in one day were burned alive in Germany because they would not renounce their own faith.
