

CRASHES ICEBERG AND SAVES SHIP; 2 SAILORS DEAD

LIVERPOOL, England, April 16.—(AP)—Seamen today credited Captain Manley, of the Canadian Pacific liner Montrose with having averted a major disaster by quick maneuvering when the ship struck an iceberg.

The ship encountered two icebergs last Monday when three days out of St. John, N. B., a member of the crew said. To have run between them would have resulted in ripping open the sides of the ship, sending her to the bottom.

Quickly sensing the situation, the captain headed the ship for the smaller of the two icebergs, which towered 100 feet above the ship. There was a loud crash like the sound of cannon. The ship came to a sudden stop. Two members of the crew were crushed to death and two passengers received slight injuries.

The bow of the vessel was crushed in from just above the water line and a gaping hole torn high up. The superstructure was smashed in. The vessel's steel plates were badly buckled. One anchor was swept away and the other jammed into the steel plates. The iceberg was split in two.

The ship rocked as if she were going over a member of the crew said. The ship backed up. Lifeboats were swung out and passengers and crew put on life belts. There was no panic and soon the ship was steady again and proceeded on her way.

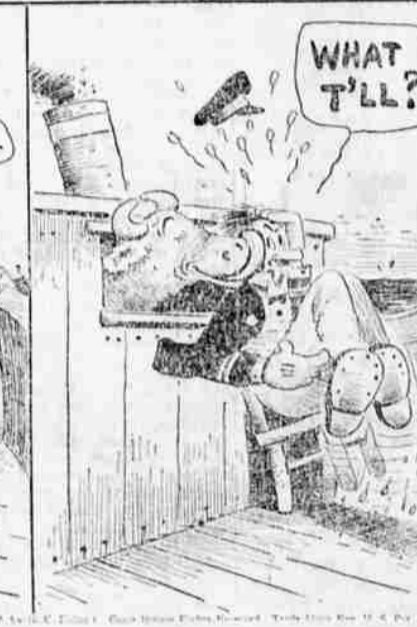
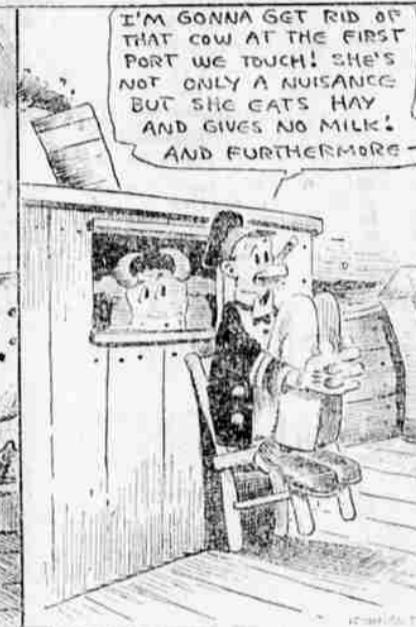
