

17 SCHOOLS OF COUNTY ENTER TYPING TESTS

Seventh Annual District Contest Held at High School in Morning—List of Entrants and Rules—Eight Medal Awards.

The seventh southern Oregon district typing and shorthand contests for high school students will be held at the Medford senior high school on Saturday morning, April 21. Mrs. E. M. Jerome, head of the commercial department, is acting as chairman for the contest.

Seventeen schools were invited to participate in this contest and they are as follows: Jacksonville, Phoenix, Ashland, Central Point, Eagle Point, Grants Pass, Klamath Falls, Talent, Rogue River, Applegate, Gold Hill, Prineville, Hilly Falls, Korb, Fort Klamath, Medford.

Those entering the contest are as follows: Advanced, called amateur, Beginners, called novice. Ashland entering with full teams, four entries in shorthand—Athena Joy, Lucille Voss, amateur; Lorraine Shelton, Nedra Earlhart, novice. Medford entering with full teams, four entries in shorthand—Marie Limber, Nina Heebma, amateur; Vivian Conn, Inez Gobhart, novice. Four entries in typing—Lillian Wick, William Purdin, amateur; Thel Anselm, Ver Dean Harvey, novice.

Grants Pass, short of full team, two entries in shorthand—Marion Turner, Robert Lutz, amateur. Three entries in typing—Helen Opdyke, amateur; Virginia Fredrick, Elizabeth Thompson, novice. Central Point entries in shorthand—George Elben, Vera Hathaway, novice. Entries in typing—Rose Stanfield, Evelyn Helt, amateur; Helen Lampert, Hildesrade Porter, novice.

Gold Hill, full typing team—Barbara McQuinn, Vernice Radeke, amateur; Jean Galverson, Clarence Wilks, novice. Rogue River, typing entries—Harriette Pickering, Pave Le Moine, novice.

From the schools entering the contest, 21 entrants in typing, 32 in novice division, 5 in amateur division, 12 entrants in shorthand, 8 novice division, 8 amateur division.

This contest, which is held annually, is conducted in the same manner and according to the same rules as the state contest held at the Oregon State college each year. These same contestants will enter the state contest on April 28. The expenses for the contest are defrayed by each district. The contestants from each school are in charge of the grading of the papers. No names of students are used. Numbers are given them by the superintendent in charge.

The first prize cup to be given to the team winning first place was presented by the Ashland chapter of commerce in 1922.

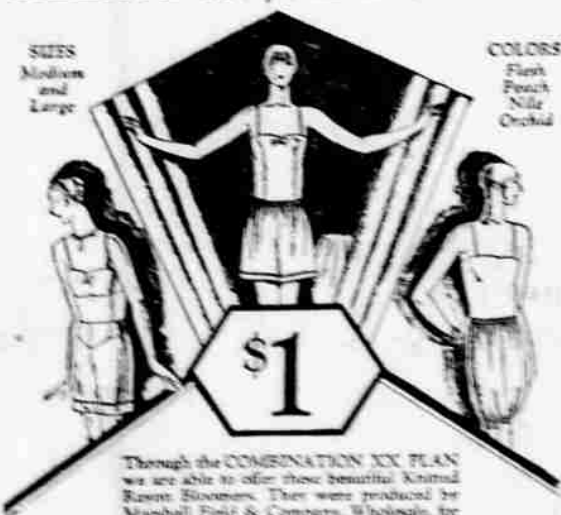
