COPCO WILL START PHONE-LINE WORK, TESTS NEW PLANT

The many local stockholders of the California Oregon Power company have just received a fine report of the company's activities during the past quarter. The report, which accompanied the regular quarterly dividend checks is reproduced as follows:

Construction. You will no doubt be interested to hear that the new Prospect No. 2 plant has been placed on the line for trial runs with gratifying success. The technical rating of the guaranteed output of the two units installed in this station is 32,000 K. W. as has been noted in previous letters. In the trial runs, however, the actual station output amounted to approximately 37,500 K. W. As these runs were conducted under normal operating conditions the results are worthy of comment. A few adjustments are being made to the machines and it is expected that by May 1 they will become a permanent part of the Copco generating system.

Plans have been perfected for the construction of the new telephone line from Medford, Oregon, to the Copco No. 2 plant on the Klamath river in California. Actual field work will begin when weather conditions permit.

New Business. In addition to the smaller appliances, many electric ranges are being constantly added to the company's lines. A recent study revealed the fact that the percentage of ranges to the total number of domestic customers is as great in the system of the Californian Oregon Power company as in the system of any utility in the United States.

Two new types of load have been recently added to the company's lines. The first covers the installation of fruit washing machines in the packing houses of the Rogue River valley. The second covers the installation of a stationary spray plant in one of the largest pear orchards near Medford. These new loads will undoubtedly develop as the benefits obtained through the use of electricity in agricultural lines become more apparent.

Preferred Stock Sales. During the past month the railroad commission of California approved the issuance of 15,000 shares of the company 6 per cent preferred stock, series of 1927. The purpose of this issue is to provide funds for the payment of the cost of new construction and additions to and betterments of the plants and properties of this company. It is contemplated that the greater part of this stock will be sold within the territory and no attempt will be made to sell this stock outside of the territory except to present stockholders, in which case sales will be limited to ten shares each. The excellent market for our securities makes them particularly attractive to subscribers selling other securities.
