

ALL SEATS FOR HOME PRODUCT BANQUET SOLD

Demand for tickets for the Community Home Products dinner tonight at 6:30 p. m. at the Hotel Medford under auspices of the Medford chamber of commerce is larger than the supply, as the 300 tickets arranged for the dinner were practically all sold this afternoon, and local citizens, who had planned on going but who did not make early arrangements, will be disappointed when they attempt to procure banquet seats this evening.

Wilson Wiley, well known Klamath Falls attorney, will be the principal speaker and while his subject has not been announced, he is expected to speak on topics of especially local interest. The annual report of the Medford chamber will be read by J. D. Russell, president of the chamber last year and it is expected to be of exceptional interest.

The meeting will be opened by President John C. Mann and turned over to Toastmaster Louis Ulrich and just preceding the main speech Seely V. Hall, chairman of the chamber aviation committee, will give a short speech on "Medford's Airport."

Instrumental music will be furnished by the Medford Elks band and vocal music will be furnished by Margaret Huntington Williamson and by the Masonic quartet, composed of Messrs. Meeker, McDonough, Howard and Shockley.

The dinner, which will feature only valley grown and Medford made products, is not only a chamber of commerce function but also a function in which the Rotary, Kiwanis, Lions and Crater clubs are taking part, each club doing its share in assuring its success.

SEND AMBULANCE TO BRING HOME MRS. E. H. PORTER

A long distance telephone message was received here at 1 o'clock this afternoon by John Perl from Dr. E. H. Porter at Madera, Calif., asking that he hurry his new modern eight-cylinder invalid carriage to that place to bring Mrs. Porter, who is in the Madera sanitarium recovering from injuries received in the bad automobile collision several days ago in California, while she and Dr. Porter and their daughter, Miss Bertha, were en route in their car to San Francisco.

This would indicate that the family are returning home, and it is understood that Dr. Porter and Miss Bertha will come along in the invalid carriage with Mrs. Porter, and that the latter two were not injured, beyond bruises, in the accident. The invalid carriage, in charge of Billy Hooker, driver, left shortly after the message was received, for Madera, which is about 400 miles distant, and the entire party is expected to arrive in Medford tomorrow or Sunday forenoon.

According to a letter Mrs. John Perl received from Mrs. Porter yesterday, and written for her mother by Miss Porter, Dr. Porter has been released from all blame for the accident. The signature of Mrs. Porter to the letter was in a tremulous scrawl, showing the nervous condition of the writer. In a very brief sentence signed by Miss Porter herself, the letter said: "Dad and I are fine."

Mrs. Porter's letter was in part as follows:

"Here I am in the Madera sanitarium with a few broken ribs as the result of an automobile accident yesterday. All the blame has been placed on the other party, and as they have suffered, I should not complain—but, oh, how I ache! It will be several days before I can leave here.

"Tell Mrs. Chaney there will be no May day party for me in Medford. Phone Mrs. Swigart that I am incapacitated for garden work, and phone Mrs. John Crews that there will be no Delphin club work. Phone Mrs. Lawson that I will miss club for several weeks. "Don't worry—nothing serious. Will all be fine. Just ribs, back and shock are my lot."
