The work to be done is the excavation and back-filling of the trench, also the placing of the cast iron pipe. All pipe and fittings are to be furnished by the city. The length of the pipe required is six hundred thirty-seven (637) linear feet of six-inch pipe.

The Water Commission will receive sealed proposals therefor, and the proposals will be opened at the office of the Water Commission, 9 West Jackson Street, Medford, Oregon, on May 7, 1928, at 8 o'clock p. m.

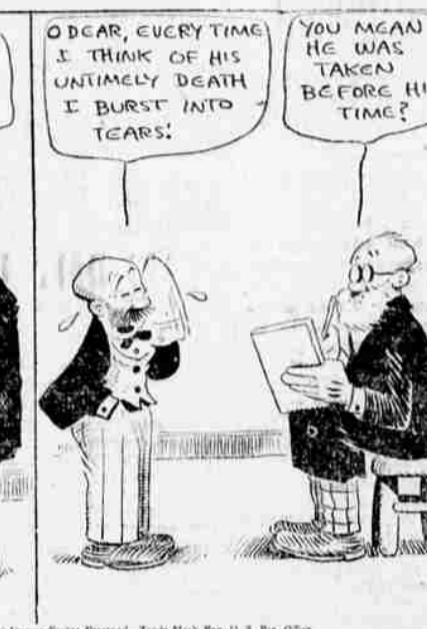
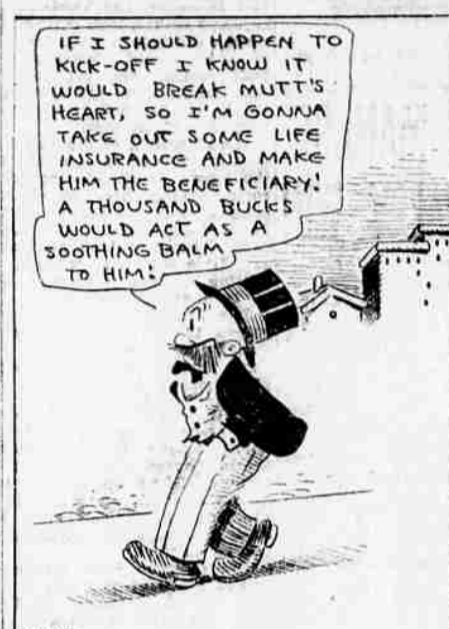
