The latest damaging pear frost in Medford's history occurred May 25 in 1924, 1922. The latest freezing temperature in local history was on June 12, 1917, when no mercury stood at 32, but no damage was done to pears by it.

EAST SIDE LEVY VOTED BY COUNCIL FLOOD EXPENSE

The city council last night with the mayor and all members present except Messrs. Keshaw and Cross, disposed of a large amount of business, and probably the most important action taken was the unanimous decision to levy an assessment on the East side area property benefiting to pay for the cost of the flood control improvements in the Bear creek channel.
