CONFIDENCE MAN NEMESIS GRABS ANOTHER VICTIM

LOS ANGELES, May 5.—(AP)—J. Frank Norfleet of Hale Center, Texas, rancher, deputy sheriff and nemesis of bunco men, says he has added another scalp to his already long string.

Last night in company with Harvey Johnson, formerly neighbor in Hale Center, but now a student at the University of Southern California, Norfleet arrested A. J. Sherrard, said to be in Amarillo, Texas, on a swindling charge. Norfleet will appear to Governor Young for extradition papers today to take his prisoner back to the Texas city for trial.

Norfleet's interest in confidence men developed in 1919 when a band of international confidence men, headed by notorious Joe Furey, mugged him out of \$40,000. Norfleet swore vengeance and started out after his men. He traveled all over the country, from Pacific to Atlantic coasts and got into a number of tight places, but finally managed to get his quarry, including Furey, who died in the Fort Worth, Texas, penitentiary in 1922.

Furey was taken in custody by Norfleet at Jacksonville, Fla.

With the arrest of Sherrard, Norfleet has in his career as a detective, captured 79 men, of whom 76 have been convicted.

Norfleet has been trailing his present prisoner for a week and finally captured him, through the latter's fondness for a young woman. The diminutive, but doughy Texan refused to name his feminine lure.
