### CHICAGO GIVES BREMEN FLIERS HEARTY WELCOME

CHICAGO, May 11.—Die zwei fliegende Deutschen and the Irishman Fitzmaurice were shaken out of the curtains of heavy dusk into the din of many thousands of "hoehs" and "bezorras" at the municipal airport last night.

"Just three big he men," exclaimed Mayor Thompson as the monocol baron, Huenefeld, an unlit cigarette drooping from his lips, the grinning Captain Koehl and mustached and uniformed Major Fitzmaurice climbed from the Junkers F-13 after a delayed hop from Cleveland.

No lonely, ice-locked Greenland island this. Instead of the lighthouse which told the sky adventurers they had finished the first east-west Atlantic flight, there was a roped-off landing field with 5000 excited welcomers crowding forward against 1000 policemen for a close-up look at a famous trio.

Yet these thousands, including the mayor, the official welcomers and city dignitaries, were not the first to smile Chicago's greeting to the Bremen fliers. The actual, though unofficial, welcome was 15-year-old John Collis, who met the airmen several miles from the airport.

John was eating dinner when he heard the roar of a plane.

"It's the fliers!" he yelled, jumping up. "They're lost!" Without stopping even for a collar or coat, John ran to the family flivver and whipped it over the road to the nearby checkerboard field, arriving as the F-13 rolled to a standstill.

"Hey, ain't you lost?" he shouted as the three men lunged crabbed legs out of the plane and looked about, puzzled, at the deserted field.

"Follow the railroad tracks to the municipal field," went on the breathless Collis. "Say, which is Fitzmaurice? Will you shake hands with me? I'm John Collis. Yes, sir; I'm glad to meet you."

Thus, most informally, with a spontaneous enthusiasm that even those at the airport a few minutes later could not outshine, the fliers were welcomed.

Major Fitzmaurice's first request after reaching the hotel was for a comb. Three were instantly offered—one black, one brown and one green.

"I'll take the green one—for Ireland," grinned the major.

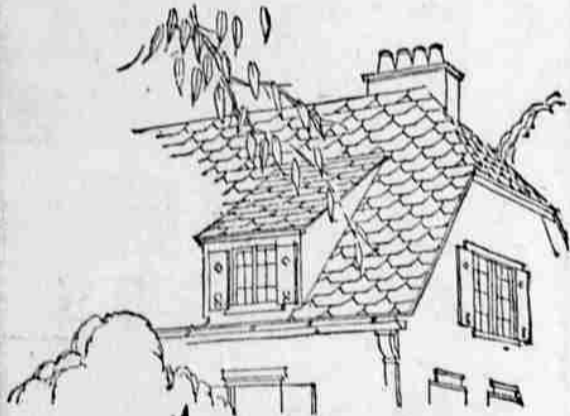
