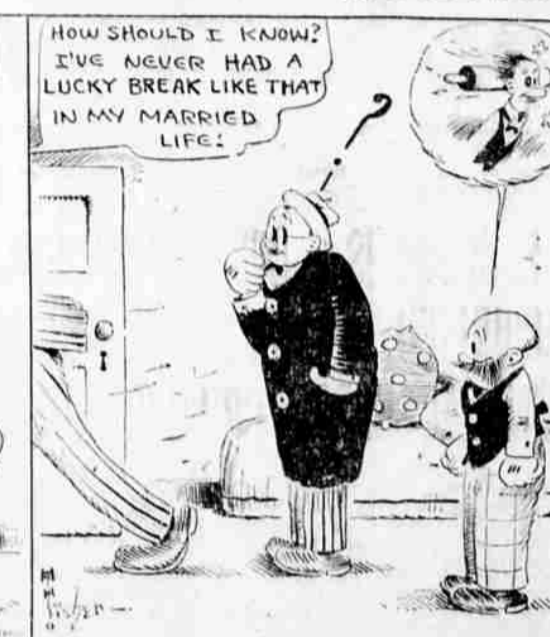

WOMEN'S FIGURING WOULD BE FATAL

NEW YORK, May 12.—(AP)—The world, in the opinion of Dr. George J. Smith, chairman of the board of examiners of the New York board of education, would crumble in fifty years if it were left to women.

"It would do so," Dr. Smith told the Columbia club, because it is impossible for women to master higher mathematics. Mathematics is absolutely necessary for culture and yet there is only a very small number of men who know it thoroughly.

This lack of knowledge, he said, was also true of other sciences. He asserted knowledge alone does not make culture but that it comes from the love of fine arts.
