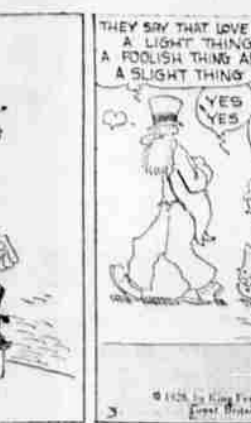
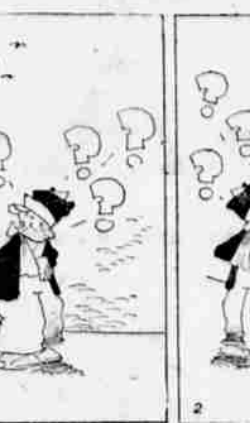
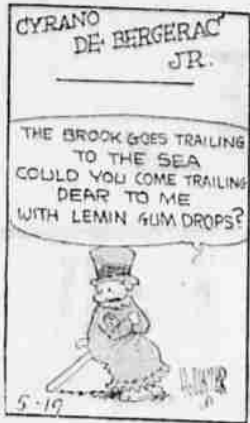

EXPLORER WOUNDED BY PISTOL SHOT

PEKING, May 19.—(AP)—Walter Granger, paleontologist with the Roy Chapman Andrews Mongolia expedition, has telegraphed the Associated Press that the shooting of Dr. Andrews was due to the accidental discharge of the leader's pistol while he was hunting an antelope.

In a telegram to his wife, Granger said that Dr. Andrews was resting under the care of Dr. Payne at the expedition's main camp at Sharamuren, 200 miles northwest of Kalgan, Granger and five other white members of the expedition motored 100 miles northeast to Ekhilin to communicate the news of the shooting to the outside world before going ahead with the next stage of the expedition which is seeking the "cradle of the human race."

A cable received by the American Museum of Natural History, New York, from Walter Granger on May 15 said that Dr. Andrews had been shot in the left leg and was not permanently injured.

Half of Haywood's Ashes to Be Buried in Chicago Graveyard

MOSCOW, May 19.—(AP)—The body of William D. (Bill) Haywood, will be cremated tonight to carry out the terms of his will by which half of his ashes are to be sent to Chicago. He directed that they were to be buried near the graves of the radicals who were executed for participation in the Haymarket riot of 1887. The other half will be buried in Moscow with the remains of the Hungarian communist, Landler. The urn will remain in Moscow until the convening of the communist international congress.
