O. S. C. INCOME LARGER THAN ANTICIPATED

COVALLIS, Ore., May 24.—(AP) President W. J. Kopp of Oregon State Agricultural college, in his report to the board of regents in annual budget session yesterday, pointed out that income from resident tuition of \$12 a term, established a year ago and non-resident tuition of \$150 a year had exceeded expectations.

New appointments, budgets for the fiscal year, beginning July 1, resignations, leaves of absence and other regular business of the institution were considered by the board.

The budget approved for the coming year, provides for an additional story of stacks for the library and other miscellaneous improvements such as permanent walks and building alterations.
