STILL HOPE FOR THE ITALIA

F THE Italia were a heavier than air machine, its present situation would be hopeless. For a forced landing in that rough and barren region of the Arctic Circle would almost cer tainly be fatal.

But failure of fuel, with a dirigible like the Italia, does not nean a forced landing. Such a ship can keep affoat for many hours after its engines stop, and can travel rapidly for many miles, by using the prevailing wind for power,

It is therefore not unlikely that when further progress in the fog and against heavy headwinds proved Empraetical, General Nobile had his ship turned about, and made for the coast

The weak point in this hypothesis is, that radio contact was lost yesterday about 9 a. m. and has not since been regained. General Nobile would almost certainly have informed his base eadquarters of any such radical change in his plans,

Nevertheless, radio failure frequently occurs, and this loss of contact does not necessarily mean that the Italia has met with a serious accident.

At any rate, while there is life there is hope, and, with the whereabouts of the Italia unknown for only 24 hours, there is good reason to believe that General Nobile and his erew are, vhatever their predicament, still alive.

When last heard from they were only 100 miles away from Spitzbergen. If a turn-about was not minde, the ship must be omewhere within a comparatively small radius, which can be covered by the relief expedition now being formed.

The entire world hopes that General Nobile and his band of ourageous men will return safely to port somewhere, or, if forced to land, will be safely rescued.
