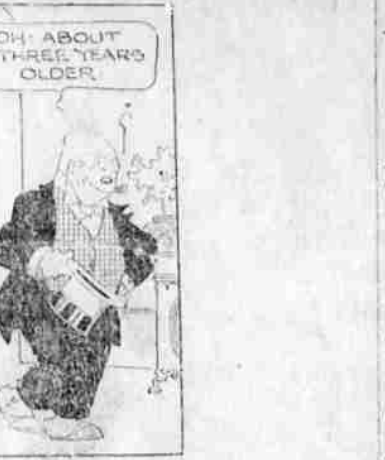
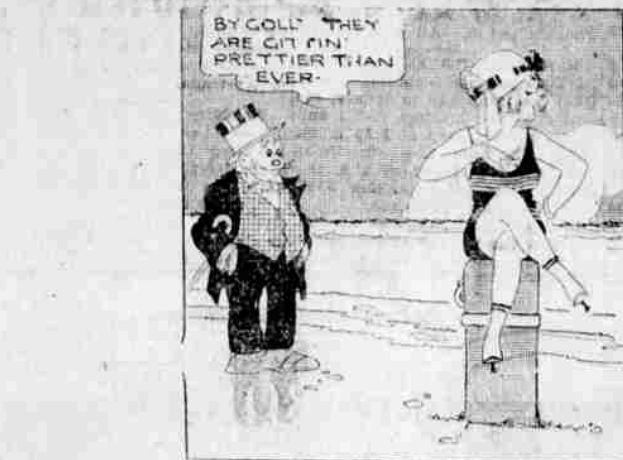

Wall Street Report

NEW YORK, June 4.-(AP) -Tightening credit conditions cast their shadow over the market again today and prices broke sharply after an early period of strength. Call money renewed unchanged at six per cent but banks called about \$15,000,000 in loans and the large institutions reported a growing scarcity in the volume of funds available for brokers' borrowings.

The closing was weak. Speculative selling for the short account met with much increase in the closing hour. Call money was jumped up to seven per cent coincident with extensive liquidation of high priced shares, causing many representative issues to sell from five to eighteen points under last week's closing figures. Radio went down eighteen points. Curtiss S. Wright T. General Motors 7 1/2. Case Threshing 7. General Electric 6. and DuPont American International and Western Union 5, from where they left off last week.
