

COOL WEATHER CHECKS SALES PORTLAND MKT.

PORTLAND, Ore., June 26.—(AP) Cool, cloudy weather tended to restrict trading on local wholesale markets this morning and movement of most commodities was slow.

New crop yellow transparent apples were in fair supply and were going to the trade at \$1.25, packed in peach boxes and around \$3.50 packed in standard apple boxes.

Strawberries were a shade firmer; first offerings selling at \$1.90 to \$2 per crate. Loganberries sold around \$1.25; raspberries \$1.75; currants \$1.75, and blackcaps \$2 to \$2.25.

Celery from the Lake Labish meadows was more plentiful and cheaper at \$1 to \$1.50 per dozen depending on size and quality, which was for the most part excellent.

Pork was a trifle firmer on country dressed meat markets. Best light hogs 14 1/2 to 15 cents this morning. Lard was easier and somewhat druggier at 19 to 22 cents. Other classes of meats were unchanged, as were also quotations on poultry.

No changes were quoted in butter and egg prices, but both markets were firm.
