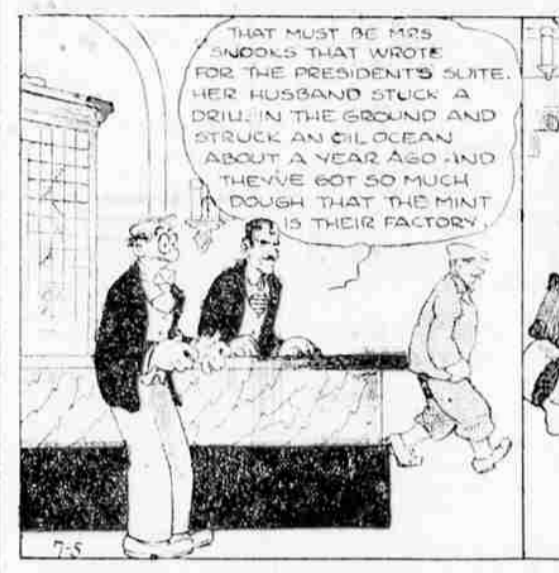
FOURTH OF JULY IN EVANSTON A FROST

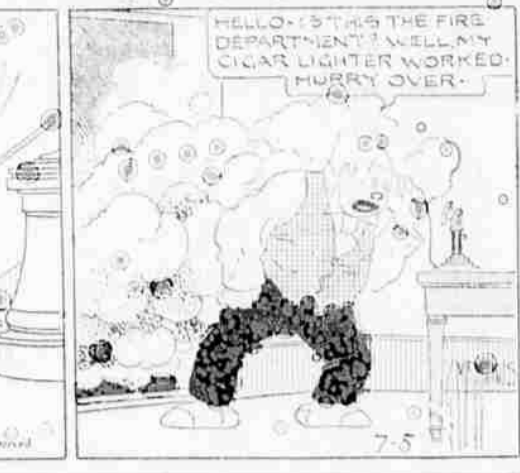

Wall Street Report

NEW YORK, July 5.—(AP)—Lowering of the call money rate from 6 to 5 1/2 per cent today stimulated the recovery in stock prices which set in early this week. Extreme caution of nearly 10 to 11 points were distributed over a broad list, with nearly a score of issues moving into new high ground. Trading showed a marked expansion in volume. The closing was strong. Continued buying of representative shares kept speculative confidence intact in late dealing and further advances of commodities to some extent, despite some realizing. A few of the blue chips like Case Thrashing came down sharply from their peaks, but others of a similar class were hustled forward, notably Du Pont. Wright Aero extended its rise to 15 points and C. I. Aero to seven. Total sales approximated 2,200,000 shares.
